Presentation Opportunities

- Texas Total Rewards Conference is a two-day regional conference with multiple speakers and topics offered as 30-40 concurrent sessions.
- A typical breakout session is 60-75 minutes including Q&A and may be repeated.
- Presentations by or including practitioners are highly valued.
- We are particularly interested in educational presentations that meet the curriculum and standards for WorldatWork, HRCI, and SHRM continuing education/recertification credits.

Submission Requirements and Selection Process

- You must provide the requested information, including a brief description (two paragraphs or less) of your presentation and 3-5 key learning objectives that will be valuable takeaways for attendees.
- The session description and learning objectives will be submitted to determine approval for HRCI and SHRM continuing education credits.
- You may also submit any sample handouts or other materials that will aid in understanding the specific topic and its relevance to total rewards professionals.

Submitted materials will be reviewed for relevance, content, and quality. If your proposal is selected for the conference program, you will be notified by July 1, 2017.

The Programs Committee will provide feedback and require any suggested revisions completed and resubmitted before the date of presentation. You will receive an email with instructions on how to submit.

Your presentation will be posted on the conference website for attendees to access. By agreeing to present, you are also agreeing to allow attendees access to your presentation, which will be available to download from our website.

Speaker Fees and Expenses

The conference does not pay speaker fees or reimburse expenses for the majority of the speaking opportunities. Travel and lodging arrangements are the responsibility of the speaker.
